Message From Dr. Durham

Dear Hagemann Families,

We have a busy week ahead with a variety of activities in the next five days! On Monday and Tuesday, our 5th-grade students are taking the science MAP test. This is the time for them to show what they know and display all of their hard work. The state uses MAP scores to assess school districts across Missouri. Districts and schools are graded based on student scores and assigned points. Last school year, Hagemann ranked #2 in points among Mehlville elementary schools. Mehlville as a district looks at individual teacher scores as well as building scores to look for proficiency, growth, and areas to improve.

Wednesday is an early release. Students dismiss at 12:55 pm for teacher professional development. Classroom teachers will be working on math and alignment among teams. It is also Administrative Professionals Day. Thank you to Mrs. Griffin and Mrs. Amelung for all they do to keep our office and school running so smoothly.

On Thursday is our much anticipated Color Run! This event will take place between 2:00-3:00 pm. Students will run on the lower lot and grassy area. Parents are welcome to run, walk, or watch!
